#### Welcome!

- Today we will be learning how to create a SSRS Membership Card using IQA.
- This Membership Card can be added to an individual's profile in your RiSE website.
- This will encourage your members to self-service.
- Please note that this same concept can be used for many other types of reports that you would like individuals to print themselves online.
  - **Example:** 
    - ▶ Certificates, transcripts, invoices, receipts and many more.



#### Assumptions

- We will be using Visual Studio 2008 to modify the SSRS Membership Card.
- Our examples will be used using iMIS 20.2.
- That you have had some exposure to the staff site.
- That you have had some exposure creating content pages.
- That you have had some exposure to the individual content profile for our organization's RiSE website.
- That your organization is using a RiSE website along with the individual profile page.



#### Overview of Training

- Create IQA with membership information.
  - Example: Full name, membership paid thru date, iMIS ID
  - Note: A dynamic filter is used to only show the Membership Card for the person who is logged in.
- Dynamically create SSRS Membership Card from IQA.
- Modify the SSRS Membership Card to meet our organization's standards.
  - Example: Add logo, font and colors.
- Upload the SSRS Membership Card to the individual profile on our organization's website.



#### Creating the IQA Query

- Login to the staff site
- Create the IQA with the membership fields that are needed.
- Use the on behalf of (OBO) feature to test your IQA query to ensure it is pulling the correct data.



# Download the SSRS (RDL) Membership Card File from the IQA

- Once the IQA query has been created and is working properly a SSRS (RDL) file can be dynamically created.
- This RDL file can then be used with Visual Basic, BIDS or SQL Server Data Tools to tweak the report.
  - ▶ Note: The reporting tool varies depending on your version of SQL.



#### Visual Studio

- Create a new project in Visual Studio
- Import in the SSRS (RDL) file that was created by IQA.
- Update the data source in Membership Card report to read iMIS data.
- Modify the report by adding a logo, update the font and colors.
  - Note: The layout of the report may also need to be modified depending on your organization's needs.



#### Upload SSRS Membership Card

- Upload the SSRS Membership Card to the staff site document system.
  - ▶ Note: Both a Reporting Services Report and Reporting Services Template will need to be added in the document system.



### Create Content Page for SSRS Membership Card

- A new content page will need to be created for the Membership Card.
- ▶ The SSRS Report iPart will be used.



## Add SSRS Membership Card to Individual's Profile

- Locate your organizations content page for the individual profile.
  - Note: This can be found under the staff site>>RiSE>>Page Builder>>Manage Shortcuts>>My Account (under your organization's website)
- Add button to report using Big Button iPart.



#### View & Print Membership Card

- Logout of the staff site.
- ▶ Login to your organization's RiSE website as a public user.
- Click on their profile.
- Click on the Membership Card button.
  - ▶ To print download to PDF.
